### How Do Utilities Join OHWARN

- Two Step Process
  - Legal Entity signs the Mutual Aid Agreement
    - Sends executed agreement to Contact Person
  - Registers Utility on the Web Site



## Non-Utility Membership

- Non-Utility Agencies or Organizations
  - Do not sign the Mutual Aid Agreement
  - They only need to register on the web site

#### Why do we need Ohio WARN?

Water and wastewater systems provide our communities with a life-sustaining resource that is of vital importance to maintaining public health, sanitation and safety. When water and wastewater services are interrupted for extended periods of time, a community's well-being quickly deteriorates, as evidenced by Hurricane Katrina. And without an adequate water supply, our communities are vulnerable to devastating fires. By restoring water and wastewater service in the most efficient manner possible, Ohio WARN provides renewed hope for fast recovery from such disasters. Ohio WARN is also available to use in non-disaster emergencies or when you may be in need of help or assistance.

#### Ohio WARN provides water and wastewater utilities with:

- A Mutual Aid Agreement (click here) and process for sharing emergency resources among water and wastewater agencies
- A mutual assistance program consistent with other statewide mutual aid and assistance programs and the National Incident Management System.
- The resources to respond and recover more quickly from a natural or human caused disaster.

## **WARN** Emergency Operation

- Utility with need sends blast e-mail from web site.
  - Or Calls District Coordinator for assistance.
- Utilities with available resources respond per e-mail.
- In a larger event these responses would be coordinated with the appropriate local or state EOC or EMAC.
  - Should scale of event warrant WARN may have presence in EOC
- WARN is designed to work in parallel with Emergency operations coordinating with local or state EMA's as situations dictate.





## Case Study

#### August 7th 2:57 PM

Good afternoon Randy,

The City of Cleveland Division of Water is in urgent need of two 24" Victaulics couplings. We have contacted Victaulic but have been informed it will take about a week before we can get them. We have had a failure on a 24" main coming out of one of our treatment plants that is affecting our entire First High pressure district.. We have implemented a workaround feed to temporarily supply the area but are not certain how well this will work – reverse flow, different pressures, etc.

Can the WARN network be contacted to see if anyone has two of these: 24" Victaulic cplg style 44 with E gasket, plated bolts and shop primer coated Part number C240044PE0. If someone does, we would need to talk with them on further details, as well as make arrangement to pick them up. They would get the new ones as soon as received. Please feel free to contact me with any questions. I can be reached at the below number until 4:30 pm, and at 216-??? anytime. You can also reach Kim Thompson, our Chief of Distribution at 216-348-7277 or by cell at 216-???-????. I have copied him as well as our WARN representative, Payton Hall.



Subject: WARN R2, R3 & R4 - Hurricane Florence Update 9/12/18

#### **FEMA Update**

• As of 5:00 a.m. EDT September 12, Florence is a category 4 hurricane with the potential to strengthen throughout the day. Florence is currently moving towards the west-northwest nearing 17 mph, with continued movement toward the west-northwest and northwest through early Thursday. Florence is expected to slow down and weaken considerably by late Thursday into Friday, but is still described as an extremely dangerous major hurricane. Hurricane-force winds extend outward up to 60 miles from the center and tropical-stormforce winds extend outward up to 175 miles, on set early Thursday.

- Assisting <u>Member</u> Utility estimation of costs
  - Team selection: personalities, commitment, expertise
  - Back-fill OT
